Blood samples for future genetic research projects can be archived free of charge at the University of Berne. If you would like to contribute a sample of your dog, please follow these instructions:

Sending Blood Samples

Approximately **6 ml EDTA blood per dog** should be sent in a suitable wrapping at room temperature. Samples should arrive at our laboratory within 5 days after sample taking. If you are located within Europe, regular mail service is sufficient. If you are located outside of Europe, please use a courier service such as FedEx. Blood samples should be clearly labelled with the name of the dog. Additionally, we need the following information:

Additional information

- If your dog was diagnosed with a specific disease, please send copies of all relevant diagnostic findings together with the blood sample.
- Please send a **copy of the pedigree** together with the blood sample.
